POSTGRADUATE STUDENTS' MEETING: Tues 16 – Thurs 18 May 2006

The Society will host its ninth residential meeting for postgraduate students from all Scottish Universities at The Burn, a mansion house situated in extensive grounds near Edzell, this May. The broad theme of the meeting will be

PURE AND APPLIED MATHEMATICS

and the aim is to provide an informal setting for students to meet others working in similar areas. Participants are encouraged to give short talks on their research and the programme will also consist of other (mainly light-hearted) intellectual activities, with ample time left for exploration of the grounds and for socialising (yes, there is a bar...).

The cost of the meeting will be subsidised by the Society, but it is necessary to make a **charge to each student of £32, payable in advance**. This covers the cost of accommodation and all meals at The Burn, from Tuesday evening to Thursday afternoon. Places are strictly limited to 30 and will be allocated (by ballot if necessary) to those who register before the **preliminary closing date of 17 March**. Registration will continue until April 07 if there are still places available.

We are not able to reimburse the cost of travel to The Burn, but you may be able to recover this and your registration fee from your department. If there is sufficient demand we shall provide transport to The Burn from a central location (e.g. Montrose station).
